Administrative Services (916) 617-4500	Comprised of two separate functions: Finance and Human Resources.
City Managers Office (916) 617-4500	Comprised of seven separate functions: Administration, City Clerk, Community Relations, Information Technology (I.T.), Economic Development, Port of West Sacramento and Risk Management.
Community Development (916) 617-4645	Comprised of separate functions: Building, Development, Engineering, Planning, Housing and Affordable Housing, Community Investment and Code Enforcement.
Parks and Recreation (916) 617-4620	Consists of three separate functions: a parks division, recreation division (including services for seniors and children) and our Tree Program. The Parks Department provides recreation and leisure opportunities with its park facilities and recreation opportunities and programs for seniors
Fire Administration 2040 Lake Washington Blvd (916) 617-4600	Comprised of four separate units: Emergency Services, Fire Prevention, Hazardous Materials and Administration.
