

# Proclamation

IN APPRECIATION OF THE ASSISTANCE OF THE  
**BRYTE AND BRODERICK  
COMMUNITY ACTION NETWORK**  
ON MORMON HELPING HANDS DAY, APRIL 30, 2011

**WHEREAS**, as part of the statewide Mormon Helping Hands Day, April 30, 2011, the Bryte and Broderick Community Action Network (BBCAN) helped recruit valuable community volunteers for improvement projects at West Sacramento parks, in association with the City of West Sacramento and the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints; and

**WHEREAS**, three park locations were selected for rejuvenation—Alyce Norman Park, Bryte Park, and River Walk Park; and

**WHEREAS**, the park sites collectively received 1,750 new trees and plants, 150 yards of mulch, 125 gallons of paint, the clean-up of 100 acres of parklands, re-irrigation of planters, new sign banners, rebuilt fences, renovation of two Little League fields with installation of scorekeeper platforms, renovation of one basketball court, and installation of fountains, benches and picnic tables; and

**WHEREAS**, BBCAN was responsible for attracting citizen volunteers in the parks' improvement project, one of the largest organized volunteer events in West Sacramento history; and


**WHEREAS**, BBCAN participated in the selection of project sites and specific improvement tasks and their successful completion; and

**WHEREAS**, the project rallied 1,200 volunteers from the community and church members to complete the parks' improvements valued in excess of \$100,000, assisted by materials and monetary donations from local businesses; and

**WHEREAS**, the entire project represents a significant contribution to the quality and future enjoyment of West Sacramento's parks.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED**, that the City Council of the City of West Sacramento does hereby express appreciation to the Bryte and Broderick Community Action Network for its efforts of April 30, 2011 to make Mormon Helping Hands Day a valuable contribution to the West Sacramento community.
